Bayer CropScience approaches misuse by involving all the stakeholders: State Affairs

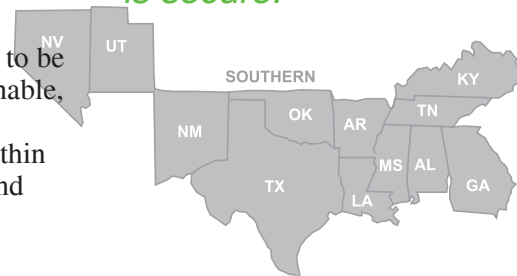
